Who?: Open to all current and incoming students who will be participating (or thinking about participating!) in next season’s “Pride of the Rockies” marching band drumline!

What?: Free teaching sessions to prepare for the 2017 fall band season. We’ll learn how to improve basic technique in a group setting and learn how to apply our technique on various marching percussion instruments. We will prepare you to audition for the “battery” percussion section...(snare drum, tenors, bass drums, cymbals)...**Battery spots will begin to be awarded during these clinics if we feel you are ready!!!**

When?: Sunday- **April 23rd, 10am-2pm (lunch provided!)** and Saturday- **May 6th, 1:30-4pm.**

Where?: UNC Jackson Field: 18th Street and 6th Ave., Greeley

Why?: These clinics are designed to “get back to the basics” of rudimental drumming. All experience levels are encouraged to attend to learn new material or review and refine material that has already been presented. **The more we learn now, the better we will perform later!**

How?: How do you participate?...**RSVP to the email below**, show up with sticks and a pad and you’re in! (I have some extra drum pads if needed) If you cannot make the entire session (come late, leave early) or you cannot make both sessions, that’s OK!
